ACCESS

The Online Bibliographic References Service provides bibliographical assistance and bibliographic research as support activities for the education process and the scientific research activity.

Access the library online catalogue: http://opac.biblioteca.ase.ro/opac/ and choose the English language. Click on the section LOGIN. Login with your IDM account username and password. From the main page of your reader account click on the **MY ACCOUNT** section and choose the Messages button. From the Messages - Online forms section, choose the Request bibliographical assistance form.

TYPES OF REFERENCES • thematic bibliographies;

- online/email references;
- bibliographies on request;
- bibliographic information;
- bibliographic research.

Completing the Request for the bibliographical assistance form

The form must contain:

- Your full name and surname;
- Subject / Theme of interest;
- The object of the research: bachelor's thesis, master dissertation, doctoral thesis, academic paper, scientific project, scientific research, information, etc.;
- Name of the Scientific Coordinator for the bachelor's thesis, master dissertations and doctoral thesis.

To find the most relevant information you can include in your request for bibliographical assistance:

- Contents of the paper;
- Keywords related to your topic;
- Sources consulted previously;
- The language/(s) of the bibliographic references;
- Other information to help in the information retrieval and documentary research processes.

The answer to your request for bibliographic references will be sent in a few working days and will be available in the Inbox section of your reader account.
